### **Military Medical City Hospital**

The Military Medical City South of Doha creates an environment in which Health, Community, Education & Wellness are assembled in one location. The City will host a hospital, research centers, staff accommodation units, residential and commercial developments area, sports and rehabilitation centers, a health museum, a library, a mosque, a community center, a hotel, and a wellness Center.

The Military Medical City Hospital is designated as a general hospital supported by state-of-the-art diagnostic and treatment departments. It will gradually transform into a referral tertiary medical center that fosters education capacity, research and development as well as a training center. It is a 400-bed-facility with total a surface area of 90,000 sqm over the medical city plot of approximately 77 Hectares.

The MMC Hospital will serve the active/retired military personnel in Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Defence civilians, Qatar Armed Forces members and employees, Ministry of Interior Employees, Emiri Guards, Internal Security Forces (ISF or LEKHWIYA) including their direct families, Qatari Armed Forces (QAF) with their subsidiaries.

Upon opening, the MMC Hospital will have 126 in-patient beds in the first phase. At full capacity the hospital will operate 400 beds, for a population base of approximately 250,000 people. The hospital will offer the following medical specialties and services:

- Internal Medicine
- Surgery
- Women's Health
- Pediatrics, Adolescent Medicine & Neonatology
- Emergency Medicine
- Laboratory & Pathology
- Diagnostic & Interventional Radiology
- Adult ICU

### The Tender

The Tenderer shall submit the proposal to fully comply with all the requirements mentioned in this document. Any deviation from the requirements or instructions will be subject to rejection. EWS reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to reject the proposal as being non-compliant.

Proposals can be submitted covering 100% of the areas that are being tendered or the tenderers can submit partial proposals for specific / particular areas according to their interest.

Proposals shall remain valid for at least 120 days from "RFP Return" date for those areas identified as "Package 1 (Building 1)" and at least, 180 days from "RFP Return" date for those areas linked to "Package 2 and 3 (Building 2 & 3)". Proposals with shorter validity period will be subject to rejection by EWS.

Incomplete proposals will be subject to rejection by EWS and may not be considered for evaluation.

Proposals submitted after the specified dates will be subject to rejection by EWS and may not be considered for evaluation.

Proposals will be evaluated based on weighted criteria, and the award will be determined by EWS, at its sole discretion.

#### Confidentiality of the RFP

This RFP, with its appendices, is both confidential and proprietary of EWS. Tenderers cannot and agree that they will not duplicate, distribute, or otherwise disseminate or make available this document or the information contained in it without the express written consent of EWS.

Tenderers shall not include or refer to this RFP in any publicity without prior written approval from EWS. All responses to the RFP will become the property of EWS and will not be returned & be entitled to retain and use information submitted by each Tenderer about this RFP, including Proposal, regardless of whether such Tenderer is awarded the Project.

This RFP does not constitute an offer by EWS, but an invitation for Tenderer response. No contractual obligation whatsoever shall arise from the RFP process.

#### **Termination / Modification of the RFP**

EWS reserves the right, at its sole discretion, at any time to:

- 1) Accept or decline all proposals from Tenderers without any explanation and whether such proposal(s) contains the most favorable fee or fully satisfies the express requirements.
- 2) Terminate the proposed project or the Tenderer selection process without notice and/or explanation, without in either case incurring any liability to the Tenderers and/or any other third parties.
- 3) Decrease or increase quantities or cancel whole items.

### **Expenses of the RFP**

All expenses for development of Proposal and participation in the RFP, including site visits, document preparation, communications, and demonstrations, are entirely the responsibility of the Tenderer and will not be chargeable to EWS. The rejection of any or all Proposals, or the termination of the RFP at any time, shall not render EWS liable for any reason.

### Purpose of the RFP

The purpose of this RFP is to solicit commercial proposals to outsource the retail shops, either collectively or individually, within the Military Medical City Hospital, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Contract duration: 5 years.
- 2. The awarded tenderers will take possession of the areas after contract signing. Tenderer(s) will have a maximum of 2 months from the contract signing date to complete all necessary fit-out work and commence operations.
- 3. 24/7 operation.
- 4. Commercial scheme: Revenue sharing in addition to a minimum guaranteed monthly rent for the location (excluding facilities management costs).
- 5. Utilities service charge equal to 5% of the commercial scheme mentioned in point #4 (previous point).
- 6. Comprehensive fit-out details, including associated costs, based on the concept proposed by the Tenderer.
- 7. Staffing details including but not limited to total numbers etc.
- 8. A description of the suggested services and products to be offered as part of the proposal.
- 9. A list of equipment and devices required to support operations, including costs and maintenance responsibilities, which will be the responsibility of the tenderer.
- 10. Necessary commercial registration, trade license, computer card, authorized signatories with their respective IDs, and a credit bureau report.
- 11. The tenderer shall maintain adequate insurance coverage throughout the contract period, including but not limited to general liability insurance, property insurance, and any other coverage required by applicable laws and regulations. The tenderer shall provide proof of insurance upon request.
- 12. Security Deposit: A security deposit, in the form of a Performance Bond (valid for one year and renewed annually) or a guaranteed cheque (for the duration of the contract), shall be required from the tenderer. The security deposit may be withheld or partially retained by EWS Management and Consultancy and Medical in the event of contract breaches or to cover unpaid fees or damages.
- 13. Tenderers are encouraged to provide any additional information, proposals, or innovative ideas they believe are relevant to the successful operation of the retail shops within the Military Medical City Hospital.
